Handwriting - The Whys and Hows behind practising handwriting

This workshop presents an overview of the developmental stages of handwriting and strategies to support handwriting development at home. Research has suggested that fluent handwriting helps support reading and writing in students from an early age (Puranik, C.S. & AlOtaiba, 2012).

Beginning with acknowledging the importance of handwriting, we will explore the development of handwriting and the underlying skills required for handwriting.

We will also be looking at strategies and tools that can be used to aid the development of handwriting skills and support your child with difficulties at home.
